

Travel guide

Please find hereunder some information on how to get to the European Commission buildings (DG INFSO) in Beaulieu.

From Brussels Airport: take the train to "Gare Centrale" and then take Metro 5, direction "Hermann-Debroux" and get off at Metro Station "Beaulieu".

From Brussels, Gare de Midi (Eurostar, Thalys): take Metro line 2 or 6 in direction "Simonis(Elisabeth)", get off at "Art/Loi" and take Metro 5, direction "Hermann-Debroux" and get off at Metro Station "Beaulieu".

It takes 2 minutes to walk from the metro station "Beaulieu" to the European Commission buildings in Beaulieu. Coming from the Metro, cross the street on your left (avenue de Beaulieu) and walk down the street. The DG INFSO buildings are all situated on the left hand side of the road starting with BU33.
