Hervé G. Floch is currently the General Manager of ALPHA - Route des Lasers & Hyperfréquences (ALPHA-RLH) french competitiveness cluster (250+ members) resulting from the merge acted end of 2016 of ex Route des Lasers, a competitiveness cluster for photonics and laser technology companies, and ex Elopsys, a competitiveness cluster for photonics, microwave and digital technologies. With 30-years of experience in optics-photonics technology development in France, he is CEA employee and since 2011 on-loan to take on the role of managing Route des Lasers, based clusters. He has record of sustained and significant contributions and patents to the development of optical coatings by the sol-gel process and precision optics for high-power lasers (Laser Mégajoule facility) and his work to develop optical thin-films and its transfer in the industry has been recognized by several awards.

ALPHA-RLH® cluster which has its head office located in Bordeaux area (France) is leading the Photonics Industrial and Market Applications (PIMAP) COSME-project. The project brings together 4 European clusters: ALPHA-RLH (France); Triple steelix (Sweden); Joesnuu SP (Finland); Produtech (Portugal), gathering 900 SMEs. The objective of this initiative is to develop economic activity and boost innovative SMEs' growth through interclustering matchmaking events, the integration of high-tech in the manufacturing and smart factory industries and their related applications.

Hervé G. Floch has been Photonics21 BoS member over the period 2012-2016.
