national trade fairs and business trips. Country-specific seminars provide key information on entering promising international markets.

The association actively supports companies of the photonics industry in attracting national and European funding, such as from the EU framework program Horizon Europe. SPECTARIS promotes Photonics as the key technology of the century inside and outside of the industry by giving presentations and writing popular books like "Photonics infographics".

In the BoS, SPECTARIS is going to be an active member of the European photonics community by establishing links between partners from industry and academia and by making the impact and benefits of the photonics industry visible to European and national politics, using the wide professional network of the association.

SPECTARIS brings the voice of many SMEs to Photonics21. Those smaller companies often don't have the manpower to send representatives to the meetings, but in total their contribution to the European photonics industry is significant and innovative. SPECTARIS is running several initiatives in the areas sustainability, health and future mobility, which help to match photonics research topics with the agenda of the European Union.

SPECTARIS has actively supported the reposition of Photonics21 on the PPP candidate list of the European commission. Activities included meetings in person with executives of the European Commission and the German Federal Ministry of Research and Education to the decision (yes, this was possible before March 2020 <sup>(2)</sup>), several letters to the decision makers and support of the position paper of EPIC contributing numerous signatures of CEOs of German photonics companies and more.

Dr. Wenko Sueptitz is the Head of the Photonics Division of the German Industry Association SPECTARIS.

After three years as Associate Research Scientist at University of Connecticut and Yale (USA), he started his career in the optical industry as a Sales and Export Manager at Linos Photonics in Goettingen/Germany in 1998. He held managing positions at Jenoptik, Schneider Optical Machines and Direct Photonics Industries.

In2013, Wenko Sueptitz accepted the position as Head of Photonics at the German industry association SPECTARIS where he is responsible of the joint activities of some 180 German companies in the field of photonics.

In the BoS he will contribute to the industry perspective of photonics based on a wide network in laser technologies, optical components and advanced manufacturing as well as connections to German and European politics what all together will be the solid background to promote and strengthen the key enabling technology photonics in Europe.
