Signify has pioneered many of the key breakthroughs in lighting over the past 125 years, laying the foundation for our current market leadership in the digital transformation of lighting. Our understanding of how light positively affects people coupled with our deep technological know-how enable us to deliver digital lighting innovations that unlock new business value and deliver rich user experiences. Moreover, we lead the industry in connected lighting systems and services, leveraging the Internet of Things to take light beyond illumination and transform homes, buildings and urban spaces.
